New starter kits will be available. Don't forget to bring a dish to pass.





For this purpose we start a subscription campaign in October every year. Although there are not so many rich Christian people in Pakistan, but we go to those people, they have the ability to give charity, and request them to pay some money from their income So poor people can also be included in Christmas happiness, because Muslim people celebrate their festivals in Pakistan with great passion.

10 years ago Mr Richard Swanson of USA sent us Santa's dress, he is now old but we are still using it and go to poor people's homes on December 24 and congratulate them with gifts and love. Please keep us in your prayers so that we can also set a good program this year too.

Our group recites rosary prayer collectively every evening at 5 PM at grotto at St. Mary's Church Khurampura and we recite first mystery for your health and your mission every day.
