



I received the package of Rosaries, today. Thank you for your generosity. This will definitely prove to be a great help to carry on our lay apostolate for promotion of rosary prayers and religious devotion to the Sacramentals.

Last Sunday we distributed rosaries in St. Peters Catholic Church, a suburb of Multan city. Here we were invited by the Vicar General Very Rev. Fr. Yusaf Sohan. We started the journey at 6 am and reached Saeed Colony at 9 am. It is a poor people's colony founded by the Catholic Church in 1980. After Mass, we distributed rosaries and sacramentals among people along with Fr. Waqas Raza OMI. Later we went to people's homes and distributed rosaries. We distributed more than 500 rosaries.

Fr. Waqas OMI appreciated our work. He has invited us to visit the annual shrine of the Holy Mary in Derekabad, a desert area of southern Punjab. This area is within five hours drive from our city. We have to set up our free rosary stall on the second day of Shrine. Thousands of people come here from all dioceses. We have done yes, but we have seven to eight hundred rosaries at this time. While we need more to distribute, but we believe that the Holy Mary will help us and fulfill all our needs

As I told you, we have been invited to the Annual Marian shrine on the 26th of October. But first we were called to the last parish of remote area of the diocese, Village B75 on 20th October. We arrived with our Assistant Parish Priest Fr. Shahzad Niamat for a 6-hour journey. It is also a desert area where the Catholic Church has laboriously settled a village. On this occasion, there were five to six hundred people from all over the parish. The village does not have the Grotto, but they have been holding the shrine for the past ten years. Holy Mass was led by our Bishop Rt. Rev. Benny Mario Travis along with Fr. Asif (Parish Priest), Fr. Shahzad, Fr. Aneel Khuram, and Fr. Nadeem Patras.

After the Mass, we distributed the Rosaries and Sacramentals from seven to nine o'clock. People were very happy to get rosaries and sacramentals. Our Bishop blessed our stall and promised to pay Holy Mass for those who send us rosaries and sacramentals. Apart from this, the priests of other parishes also appreciate our work and invite our group in their parishes for free distribution of Rosaries and Sacramentals.

Thank you so much for your help. But we need your continues support so that we can continue our work. You have a request that if you have crosses, medals, and scapulars then kindly must send it to us because people ask us about them too, but now they have very few.

Thank you once again; we hope you keep sending us rosaries and other Sacramentals so that God's name is glorified in Pakistan (pictures of the event are attached for your information)
